

## **Requirements for Non Iucrative visas**

A Non lucrative visa is issued for foreigners who wish to reside temporarily in Spain without undertaking business activities.

After the visa has been granted the applicant must apply for a residence card in Spain not less than one month after entering Spain.

## **Documents required:**

- 1. **2 visa applications dully filled:** Applications that do not include all the required data will not be accepted. <a href="http://www.exteriores.gob.es/Consulados/MIAMI/es/InformacionParaExtranjeros/Documents/National\_Visa\_Application.pdf">http://www.exteriores.gob.es/Consulados/MIAMI/es/InformacionParaExtranjeros/Documents/National\_Visa\_Application.pdf</a>.
- 2. A passport with at least 1 year validity and its copy.
- 3. 2 photographs, colour, with white background, less than 6 months old.
- 4. Proof of economic means to afford the costs of living during the period of residence as well as the return expenses. For 2017:

For monthly own maintenance: 2.130 €

For monthly each member of the family maintenance: 532.51 €

- 5. Residence application form (Ex0 1). To be submitted at the Embassy. http://extranjeros.empleo.gob.es/es/ModelosSolicitudes/Mod\_solicitudes2/01-Formulario\_residencia\_no\_lucrativa.pdf
- Residence fee (Form 790-052). Charged at the Embassy.

- 7. Photocopy (full page) of your medical insurance (covering 30.000,00 €) including repatriation in case of emergency, covering the whole stay in Spain and all Schengen States.
- 8. **Medical certificate in English** stating the applicant does not suffer from "any of the diseases that might have serious consequences for public health, according to the 2005 International Health Regulations (IHR)":
  - a. small pox
  - b. poliomyelitis due to wild type poliovirus
  - c. human influenza caused by a new subtype, and
  - d. severe acute respiratory syndrome (SARS)

- 9. Police Clearance Certificate in English issued by the relevant authorities of the country of nationality or residence, regarding the last 5 years. The validity of the certificate is 3 months. If the certificate is issued by other foreign authority, the certificate must be legalized by the concerned Ministry of Foreign Affairs and the Spanish Embassy in that country.
- 10. Documents required for family members in addition to core documents of the re-grouping person (sponsor) are:
  - For **spouse**: Marriage certificate (**duly legalized**).
  - For **children**: Birth certificate (**duly legalized**)

If the certificate is issued by other foreign authority, the certificate must be legalized by the concerned Ministry of Foreign Affairs and the Spanish Embassy in that country and a translation into Spanish if the certificate issued is not in English.

Presenting all the above-mentioned documents does not imply or guarantee that the visa will be granted. These documents are part of the requirements established by the Spanish legislation on Immigration matters. The final decision lies with the Spanish Consular authorities.

The Embassy of Spain may ask for any other documents considered to be necessary. A personal interview may also be requested.

The visa application must be submitted in person. A personal interview is requested.





## THE VISA PROCEDURE WILL TAKE ONE MONTH OR MORE TO BE FINALIZED.

VISA FEE IS 60 EUROS, THE LOCAL CURRENCY OF 2,300 BAHTS.
